1. The Baby Ruth candy bar was created in 1920 by Curtiss Candy Co. They named this bar after President Cleveland's daughter.

5. A chocolate cake should be baked at a little lower temperature than any other kind of cake because chocolate burns easily.

7. Hershey was not the first company in the U.S. to manufacture chocolate. It actually was first produced in 1765 by the John Harmon Company.
8. Cocoa is not a native plant to Hawaii. The cocoa bean (tree) was brought to Hawaii around 1830. Remember, it is addictive. So, someone needed their chocolate fix and had to grow the tree!
9. Baking chocolate doesn't have any milk solids in it. Unsweetened baking chocolate is bitter. It comes closest to the raw, natural bean.
10. Chocolate is just as good for you as a glass of red wine. Research shows that dark chocolate, just like red wine, contains flavonoid phenolics which are known to lower the risk of heart disease. Cocoa is approximately 20% protein, 40% carbohydrate and 40% fat before adding sugar and milk.
